- Ordered replacement plastic covers for latches on windows. Some replaced, has extra for future replacements
- Women's bathroom by flower cooler: the exhaust fan was unplugged, gets hot and fan does not work. Needs new motor
- Paint touched up in men's bathroom by cooler, dividers between toilet and urinal.
- Found a different model of tarring machine that is better quality and more stable (RY10 PRO). Is walk behind, has 4 wheels, center heating system, more efficient, less tippy, tar dispensing tank made of stainless steel, valving on the inside vs. outside, uses tar blocks as well (rubberized, sets up after 1 hour). Total cost (without tax) \$3,778.
- Concerns elevated with future individuals' availability to run machine, do maintenance, etc. discussion had
- Casey communicated with the city and use of their machine. They use bulk tanks for tar, concern with pricing/use
- Would like to move forward soon, due to shipping time and need to work on parking lot as soon as possible
